



Day 1 God Protects Us

BIBLE STORY:

Exodus 2:1-10, Baby Moses

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Who was Moses? Why was Moses in danger? What did Moses' mother do to protect him? Who adopted Moses and saved him? Is there anything happening in your life where you need God's protection?

MEMORY VERSE/ACTIVITY: "I can do all this by the power of Christ. He gives me strength." Philippians 4:13 (NIRV)

LESSON ACTIVITIES:

- **Word Scramble.** Print or write the verse as a word scramble on a piece of paper. For example: heT odrL si ym hpeeSdrh ("The Lord is my Shepherd." Psalm 23). See who can be the first to unscramble it.
- **Find Baby Moses:** Items needed-small baby doll/baby pic/cut out. Hide the baby item somewhere in the room. Have kid(s) seek out baby Moses. God helped Moses' mommy keep Moses safe. Nothing is impossible with God.

PRAYER: *Dear God, Thank you for keeping us safe, and letting us know you are always near us. In Jesus' name, Amen.*

Day 2 God Shows Me What's Right

BIBLE STORY:

Exodus 3:1-12, The Burning Bush

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: Who did God speak to through a burning bush? What piece of clothing did the voice tell Moses to remove? Where did God want Moses to go?

LESSON EXPERIMENT:

Supplies Needed: *Glass jar or cup, vegetable oil, water, red food coloring, Alka Seltzer tablets*

ADVANCED PREPARATION: Fill the glass container one third of the way with water. Add a few drops of food coloring and mix to turn the water red. Fill the remainder of the container with oil.

DIRECTIONS: *Show the glass to your kid(s)*

***Say:** This glass is here to remind us of the burning bush that Moses saw. Seeing a bush on fire wasn't special in itself. What made it special was that God was there, and the bush did not burn up.

Drop an Alka Seltzer tablet into the glass. As the tablet dissolves, it should send bubbles of water floating up into the oil.

***Say:** God used the burning bush to get Moses' attention. God had a special mission for Moses, to free his people from the evil Pharaoh. God knew what was right; Moses was scared, but he put his trust in God. God shows us what is right, even if we don't know.

PRAYER:

Dear God, There's nothing you don't know. Show me what is right. Amen

Day 3 Nothing is Too Hard for God

BIBLE STORY:

Exodus 7:8-21, Moses Confronts Pharaoh

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Who went with Moses to talk to Pharaoh?

What happened when Aaron put his staff on the ground? Who gave Moses the strength and courage to talk to evil Pharaoh?

LESSON ACTIVITY:

"Aaron's Staff" Snack

Supplies needed-Teddy Grahams, frosting, pretzel sticks, gummy worms

ADVANCED PREPARATION: On a plate, set two Teddy Grahams. Use a small amount of frosting to attach a pretzel stick to the hand of one of the Teddies. Place a gummy worm at the foot of the other Teddy.

CONNECTION: The Teddy Grahams remind us of Moses and Aaron who God sent to talk to Pharaoh. When Aaron threw his staff down, it turned into a snake, showing the power of God. By God's power, we have the strength to face anything. Nothing is too hard for God. God helps me do things that are hard, even when I don't think I can.

SUMMARY:

Confronting Pharaoh was really scary for Moses, but God gave him the strength to do it and helped him at every step. God showed Moses and Pharaoh that no one is stronger than God.

PRAYER:

Dear God, Nothing is too hard for you. Give us strength and courage when things are scary. Amen.

Day 4 God Always Has A Plan For Us

BIBLE STORY: Exodus 14:13-29, Parting of the Red Sea

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: How were the Israelites trapped?
What did God tell Moses to do? How did the Israelites cross the Red Sea?
How can we remind ourselves to turn to God in those difficult times?

LESSON ACTIVITY: Moses Parting Sea Craft

Supplies needed: Pencil/markers/crayons, glue/tape, scissors, paper for walking trail and blue paper for waves

1. Draw and cut out the shape of a man to be Moses. Or, have them draw a picture of Moses with his arms outstretched on a small piece of paper. Decorate the blue paper with drawings or stickers of fish.
2. Next, cut a piece of blue paper in half. Cut both pieces of the blue paper at one inch notches going long ways down the page. Don't cut all the way through, but only go about half way. Use a marker/pencil to roll the strips back toward the solid part of the paper, forming the "waves" for the Red Sea.
3. Glue the two blue pieces of paper on top of the other paper, with the waves facing toward the middle of the paper, so there's a strip going down the middle. Then place Moses at the edge of the Red Sea.



PRAYER: Dear God, Help us to trust in you, and know that you have a plan for each of us. In Jesus' name, Amen

Supplies: Small dish, water, black pepper and dishwashing detergent

1. Shake black pepper all over the water. Can you see the pepper floating on top of the water? Now, place your finger into the water and touch the bottom of the dish. What happened? You are right -- nothing happened!
2. Next, take just a drop or two of this dishwashing detergent and put it on the tip of your finger. Now, again place your finger into the water and touch the bottom of the dish. Now, watch carefully. Did you see what happened? The pepper all separated and moved to the sides of the dish!

The Israelites thought they were doomed when they reached the Red Sea, but God already knew the way to safety. God parted the waters for the Israelites, showing them that God always has a plan for us.

And when the Israelites saw the mighty hand of the LORD displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the LORD and put their trust in him and in Moses his servant. Exodus 14:31 (NIV)
