

Fizzy Science Lemonade



Relax and enjoy a refreshing glass of lemonade while doing science! Here's an easy way to turn ordinary lemonade into fizzy sparkling lemonade. The project works on the same principle as the classic baking soda and vinegar volcano. When you combine an acid and baking soda, you get carbon dioxide gas, which is released as bubbles.

Ingredients

2 cups water
1/2 cup lemon juice
1/4 cup sugar
sugar cubes
baking soda
food coloring (optional)

Directions

- Mix together the water, lemon juice, and sugar. (Heating the water and then adding sugar will help sugar dissolve.)
- For extra fun, draw faces or designs on sugar cubes using toothpicks dipped in food coloring.
- Coat the sugar cubes with baking soda. You can roll them in the powder or shake sugar cubes in a small plastic bag containing baking soda.
- Pour some of your lemonade into a glass. When you're ready for the fizz, drop a sugar cube into the glass. If you used food coloring on the sugar cubes, you can watch the lemonade change color.

What is your favorite part about school?


